This list is intended to help you find out whether you have to pay tuition fees. Please note that this list is for guidance only and does not constitute a binding statement on the obligation to pay fees.

What type of degree program are you applying for?

From the winter semester 2024/25, tuition fees for international students from third countries will only be charged for newly enrolled students on Bachelor's and Master's degree programs.

Studienkolleg, exchange studies, other

You will continue to pay the regular semester fee. According to your information, no fees will be charged for international students from third countries in your case.

Persons with citizenship from these countries or regions are exempt from the obligation to pay fees:

- Germany
- All EEA countries (EU + Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway)

For persons with dual citizenship, citizenship from one of the countries or regions listed above is sufficient to be exempt from the obligation to pay fees.

German or EU/EEA

- at least one parent has been legally employed in Germany for at least 3 of the last 6 years.
